


SSO Today

Current Landscape

- Organizations with 50+ seats
- Microsoft Entra ID & Okta Workforce Identity Cloud
- OpenID Connect (OIDC) protocol support
- Automated user management via SCIM provisioning
- IT Admin lead user reconciliation for data retention

Known Limitations

- Data reconciliation can be cumbersome
- Difficulty adding and removing domains
- Limitations around updating client secrets

Future SSO Landscape


Upcoming Enhancements

- Alternative reconciliation options for Studio data
- Ability to bypass user reconciliation
- Easily add or remove domains without turning off SSO
- Update client secrets with ease




Streamline Revu Installations

- Pre-configure profiles and tool sets
- Includes Revu + OCR components
- Command line script support

- Microsoft Intune
- KACE
- Group Policy deployment

Existing Functionality

- **Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops** fully supported
- **Persistent and non-persistent** support via auto-logout scripts for session cleanup
- **VMware/RDS support:** While not officially supported, customers have been able to configure these successfully.


Impact on Integrations and Studio User Management

What Prime Originally Solved

- **Lack of administrative oversight** into Studio usage and collaboration
- **Integration capabilities** between Bluebeam and enterprise systems


The Evolution Timeline

- **2010:** Studio Sessions launched (real-time collaboration)
- **2012:** Studio Projects added (document management)
- **2015:** Studio Prime introduced (administrative control + API access)
- **2022:** Subscription model announced
- **June 2025:** Integrations exclusively on the New Integrations Platform launched (Prime-free connectivity)
- **Sept. 2025:** Org Admin Pro Launch


